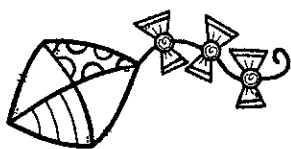
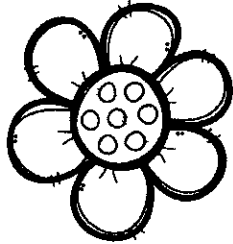
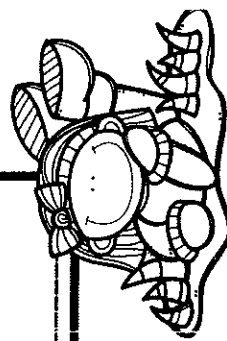


# SPRING BREAK READING CHALLENGE
