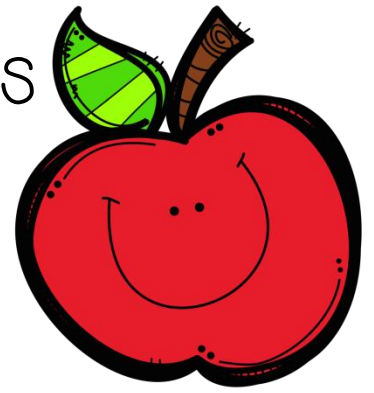


MRS. ERNST'S CLASS
